




## Haslemere Museum Guidelines

	<p>We've been very busy ensuring we can reopen safely to protect our visitors, staff and volunteers, and we are very pleased to have reopening on Tuesday August 11<sup>th</sup>. We are entrance by donation and in these Covid-19 times your donation is more important than ever. You can donate by cash or credit card or online <a href="#">here</a>.</p>
	<p>To ensure everyone's safety things will be a bit different on your visit: We will initially open Tuesdays, Wednesdays &amp; Thursdays 11am to 4pm. We will not be requiring advance booking but might need to ask you to come back a bit later if we are really busy.</p>
	<p>We ask that you maintain the 2m social distancing between yourself or your group and other visitors. This is the same as having Arthur the Bear lying at your feet! When you arrive please wait outside if necessary, in order to keep to 2m distancing.</p>
	<p>Please sanitize your hands when you arrive. There will be additional sanitising stations around the Museum for your use.</p>
	<p>Please wear a face covering whilst in the Museum building.</p>

	<p>When you arrive we will ask you for contact details for NHS Track &amp; Trace; this information will be destroyed after 22 days and will only be used for NHS Track &amp; Trace.</p>
	<p>We will be operating a one-way system around the Museum, please follow the signs and give way to others if necessary. Download a map <a href="#">here</a>. In certain areas, for example the Mummy and Geikie rooms we ask that only one visitor or group enter at a time; please follow the instructions.</p>
	<p>Initially we will only be using the disabled toilet. This ensures we can carry out frequent cleaning and prevents pinch points that do not allow for social distancing. If you need to queue please do so along the corridor as signposted to prevent congestion.</p>
<p><b>Other Things to Know:</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•The Library and Archive are closed until further notice.</li> <li>•The Visit Haslemere leaflet section is closed until further notice.</li> <li>•For the safety of our visitors we have removed backpacks and quizzes from reception. However, you can download quizzes <a href="#">here</a> and there will be a trail in the galleries to follow that will spell out a famous exhibit.</li> <li>•You can book one of our activity backpacks in advance <a href="#">here</a>. This is limited to one backpack per family per visit. It will be available for you on arrival and then on return will go into quarantine for a minimum of 72 hours.</li> <li>•The gardens are open and there is a one-way route around the grounds; please follow signs. Unfortunately, the observation bee hive will not be open this year although we are still looking after the bees in our outside hives.</li> <li>•The Museum will be cleaned frequently by staff and our contract cleaners to ensure everyone’s safety.</li> <li>•Initially the shop will remain closed due to the additional staffing and cleaning regime required in order for it to be opened safely.</li> </ul>
