Jonathan Pile RIBA

Jonathan is a RIBA Chartered Architect, director of international practice Oval Partnership and principal of Integer, an action-research organisation for new sustainable building strategies. He grew up in Grayshott from the age of five until leaving to study architecture at University College London, where much later he was to teach for twelve years. The Museum, where he would spend many happy hours as a child, had a profound and lasting influence on him, and on his creative work. Jonathan lives in Deptford, SE London, with his wife Katherine, son and two cats, in the award-winning low-energy timber-framed house they designed for themselves.

Jonathan has served one term of three years as a Trustee of Haslemere Educational Museum, during which time, working closely with the property manager, he has guided the conversion of Museum House, the insulation of the Museum roofs to reduce energy costs and commissioned a detailed building fabric survey and environmental services strategy to guide all future work towards greater sustainability. It is proposed he be appointed as a Trustee for a second term of three years.
